CASBHC Background

A school-based health center (SBHC) is a health care facility located in or near a school. It provides primary care services to students, addressing both physical and mental health needs. SBHCS are staffed by qualified health professionals and offer services such as physicals, immunizations, well-checks, behavioral health and oral health services.

Purpose of Request for Proposal (RFP)

To solicit contractors to deliver grant writing services for CASBHC on a fee for services basis in two main capacities:

- First, the grant writer shall seek out general funding opportunities to sustain CASBHC.
- Second, the grant writer will pursue funding for CASBHC to develop programming related to strategic plan goals and sustain program needs.

This will be achieved by developing, writing, and submitting grant proposals to federal, state, local and private funding sources. Funding sources will be approved through collaborative decision-making between the grant writer and CASBHC's executive and finance team.

Objectives and Services Requested

- Identifying avenues of funding that address and support general operating and program expenses through a racial and health equity lens.
- Pursue sustainable funding to maintain the work of CASBHC
- Broaden CASBHC's funding to expand the programs and services provided to the school-based health centers and its clients
